Repairs and maintains Injection Molding tools, machinery and facility by performing the following duties.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Understands and practices safe working procedures. Uses personal
 protective equipment with lockout/isolation procedures as required.

 maintenance duties and work toward reducing them.
- Ability to communicate openly and clearly with fellow associates. Read or write and understand specific work instructions and procedures. Understands and practices sharing information with others.
- Use of hands and power tools to expedite repairs, installation, and maintenance of plant equipment.
- Use overhead crane in safe manner to transport tools.
- Use of shop power machinery, lathes, milling machines, saws, dills and grinders.
- Perform seasonal duties outside of buildings such as snow removal around overhead doors.
- Ability to select and identify correct fasteners to install various materials and plant equipment.

- Keep chains, slings and eye bolts organized and ensure safe for use.
- Order replacement parts for mold maintenance shop including crane.
- Assist in injection molding machine repairs
- Assist in takeout devices repairs
- Assist with feeding system maintenance and repairs
- Fill out documentation required for mold maintenance job.
- Assist to troubleshoot pneumatic systems including valves, regulators, filters and actuators.
- Assist to troubleshoot hydraulic systems including valves, pumps, filter/strainers, flow control.
- Complete PM work orders of equipment to manufacturer's recommendations or PM guide and provide feedback on activities and changes to improve the service or equipment.
